
MARCH MEETING





Launch occurred approximately at 11:45 am. The balloon went off towards Block Island. Very cold, windy at times - close to 8 mph.



Data from this launch was collected by the museum's computer. Below is the path that the balloon followed. Planning for the next balloon launch is in progress.
