









WINTER FIELD DAY COMING UP JAN 25-26




SILVER ANNIVERSARY FACTOID

A day or two after Field Day 1995, Fred KB1BU, Tom WV1C, Barb KA1SHN & Gary WE1M got together and formed the Housatonic Amateur Radio Club. It's purpose was to put our families (especially our children) on the air and to teach them about ham radio! We drew up a constitution and applied for a callsign. Back then, once you obtained a callsign, it took about 6 months for it to show up in the call book. Here is a snippet from the 1996 Radio Amateur Callbook showing our first callsign KB1BRB.
