Below are pictures of our team fixing our beam so it's ready for summer Field Day.









We are now focusing our attention on holding a class at the University of Bridgeport for UB Grad students and CERT members in September, 2019. Negotiations are currently underway.


PICO BALLOON LAUNCH



KILOWATT 1 BARNUM SPECIAL EVENT STATION


HARC and WAS will operate a special event station honoring the life and times of the great showman, P.T. Barnum.

This was approved on Monday 4/15/19. We have the callsign from September 7 through September 21, 2019. Gary also requested via Dan N3DAW the use of WAS for this event and this was also approved. So, if you

think you had a great time at the last PT Barnum special event station or the Nathan Hale special event station, attend this one!

We plan on two stations running amplifiers this time. We will put one station on the trapped vertical antenna and another possibly on the off center fed dipole. Time will tell if we can run the beam. (Jeff KB1LZ in looking at the beam.)

Operations should commence on Saturday September 7 after a nice breakfast at Sherwood diner. We need operators, so please consider attending and be sure to have a really fun time!


