





After a great breakfast, we went to WAS and set up one station to operate Multi-operator, single transmitter and operated for about 8 hours. Making contacts for N1KT were Jeff KB1LZ, Mike KA1EOU, Gary WE1M and David KB1LTW. We used both the newly repaired vertical (thanx Mike) and the off center fed dipole.
