




ARRL 10 METER CONTEST

At the December meeting, we decided that Dan N3DAW would operate from WAS and anyone who wanted to join him would operate there. Members who wanted to operate from home could use their own callsign and put "Westport Astro ARC" as their club name when submitting scores. Dan said he would use K1WAS.

WAS was reserved for us. The contest began 0000 UTC Saturday and ran through 2359 UTC Sunday. Dan set up one station and operated solo. His report is that the band was poor and full of noise.

WINTER FIELD DAY JANUARY 29 & 30

Winter Field Day is being held in January! Yep, it is a the end of this this month, just weeks away and we are looking for a chairman to run it! If you would like to take a turn at running a Field Day operation, let Larry AB1JC or Dave KB1LTW know. It really is easy. Winter Field Day is January 29 & 30, 2022.

WFD Assn has released their "readjusted" rules for 2022. They have reduced the number of points allowed for bonus' from 1000 to 500. This is a welcome change, putting bonus points in harmony with QSO points. However, they still staunchly refuse to allow FT8 as a valid mode. WFDA also revisited the power classifications. New this year, there are only two power classes, QRP and 100 watts or less. Power greater than 100 W is not allowed at all. This leaves those wanting to run more than 100 watts two options: lower your power to 100 watts and put up with it, or run power but do not submit the score. By not submitting the score, a ham station is only bound by FCC rules and contest rules become meaningless.
